

Extra credit: There are no “right” answers to the following questions...I will, however, give you no credit if you do not explain yourself. Answer one, none, or all of the following:

- Is it acceptable for a sibling to offer bone marrow to another sibling suffering from a blood disorder? Is it acceptable to create a child who can donate cord blood at birth for the same purpose?
- If the procedure were available, should deaf parents be allowed to select for a child who will also be deaf?
- What if a more mature couple wishes to have a child but is determined not to have a child with Down syndrome? Is discarding embryos with trisomy-21 (before they are implanted into the woman) better than aborting after a diagnosis has been obtained during pregnancy?
- Should using genetic tests for “family balancing” be an acceptable practice? (Testing embryos for gender and only implanting those of the desired sex)
