

# “Scruples” Activity

1. After a busy afternoon of soccer practice and an evening band concert, you arrive home at 10 PM completely exhausted. Even though you have at least two hours of homework, you decide to go to bed and just deal with the consequences. At school the next morning, a friend offers to let you copy all of her homework. Do you accept her offer?
2. One of your friends has a new girlfriend. You see the new girlfriend out at the movies with somebody else. It is obvious to you that she is cheating on your friend. Do you tell?
3. Your younger brother would like to go skiing with his friends, but your family does not have the money to pay for the trip. At school, you see a suspected drug dealer drop a \$100 bill in the hallway. No one will see you pick it up. Do you take the money and give it to your brother?
4. A friend just bought a CD that you would love to have and offers to make a copy for you on her CD burner. She will only charge you \$3.00. Do you accept the offer?
5. Based on a conversation you overheard at lunch, you know that two of the students in your fifth period come to class high. Do you report them?
6. You are invited to a big party the same weekend of an overnight band trip. You really want to go to the party and are considering telling your parents that you are going with the band. Unless something unexpected happens, it is unlikely that you will get caught. Do you do it?
